- Build an expert teaching team with a focus on English and Mathematics
- Establish a Student Services Hub to support an inclusive model of education

## Targets

- English, Mathematics and Science A-C 90%
- Upper two bands:
  - Year 3 Reading 50%
  - Year 3 Writing 50%
  - Year 3 Numeracy 40%
  - Year 5 Reading 40%
  - Year 5 Writing 40%
  - Year 5 Numeracy 30%
- Year 3 and Year 5 Closing the Gap declining
- 100% of teachers receive formal feedback around the teaching of English and Mathematics
- 100% of students identified through NCCD have PLP and/or ICP and/or support provisions on OneSchool
- Teacher planning documents include differentiation for identified students (reasonable adjustments and teaching strategies are evident)

## Our initiatives include

- Agreed practices for the teaching of English and Mathematics
- Inquiry Cycle review of the Pedagogical Framework
- A Case Management process for students requiring support (attendance, attainment, engagement)
- Implementation of a Zones of Regulation
- Continue with PBL implementation (transition to Student Code of Conduct)
